If the nomination is in line with our exchange agreement, the students then receive a link to the on-line application form* 3. Once students are accepted, they receive an email confirmation containing their applicant number. The applicant number allows students to apply for University accommodation <p>* Note that our application process is electronic. We do not accept paper applications</p>
